A Contemporary House on the Links

Following in the Pacific Northwest's rich tradition of wood houses is a two-story residence completed in 2005 by Seattle architect Tyler Engle. The cedar-sided, metal-roofed house sits on roughly half an acre, just off the eighth tee of the Canterwood Golf and Country Club in Gig Harbor. Engle's 4,628-square-foot open plan is thoroughly engaged with nature, thanks to his generous use of windows and French doors. There are four bedrooms and 4.5 baths.
